# What is the Grandmaster Spelling Challenge?

Spelling matters! The Grandmaster Spelling Challenge has been put together to incorporate the National Curriculum lists from Year 5 and 6 and some of the first 100 high frequency words (in bold). Each 'belt' has been broken down into between 10 and 15 spellings.

Children are encouraged to learn these spellings at home alongside their home learning and will be tested in school.

If a child does not get all the spellings in their belt correct, they will be retested on the same level belt until the teacher is confident that they are ready to move on.

You will be informed which belt your child is working towards. A booklet is available on the school website to download or print at home. Please email your class teacher if you require a paper copy.
