Covid-19 update

The following extract (in italics) is taken from the latest West Sussex letter to parents sent separately.

The reality is that, while you and your school continue to remain vigilant, Covid-19 is still in our communities and cases in West Sussex schools are very high and rising. We need to keep working together to limit the spread of the virus. Here are some simple things you can do to support your school:

Close contacts should take a PCR test

<u>At Holbrook, if there is a positive case in your household</u>, we would <u>strongly encourage</u> you to get a PCR test for your child and keep them at home until the result comes through. This absence will be authorised for Covid-19 reasons.

As an extra protective step, the Government is asking <u>close contacts to also take a home test (LFD) before they attend school.</u> This important step will greatly reduce the chances of your children bringing the virus into school. This includes primary children and we know that even young children soon become familiar with this quick testing.

Due to the increase in cases, we are currently reviewing our plans for the second half of the Autumn term which may result in strengthening our risk assessment further, for example reintroducing bubbles, limiting face-to-face parents/carers events, assemblies and educational visits. Further information will be communicated next week.
