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# Autumn term theme

<u>Dragons and Drawbridges</u>

**English** - We will be writing information booklets about dragons, learning and writing about castles and looking at story structure through stories about knights.

Maths – Our units are on place value within 10 then within 20, addition and subtraction within 10, and 2D and 3D Shape.

**Science** - Work will focus on materials and their properties.

History - We will be looking at the history of our local area and how castles have changed through the years.

Geography - We will focus on our local area and we will be learning about maps.

**Computing** – Programming robots and animation.

**Art** – Portraits inspired by Picasso and dragon sketching.

**RE** – We will be learning about Christianity, including the Creation story and the Christmas story.

DT – We will focus on simple mechanisms – including making a moving picture

## Reading books

Your child will be bringing home a phonics reader, as well as a picture book from our Y1 library to share at home. Please can phonic reader books and the Reading Diaries be in school every day please. We will have a box for books you wish to change and every child should change their books at least once a week.

### Home learning

Home learning will be sent via Seesaw every Friday to be completed by the following Thursday. This will consist of reading (preferably daily), spelling/phonics and maths. We suggest that you spend at least 15 minutes on the things that will support your child's learning the most, in addition to regular reading.
