Safeguarding concerns must be shared without delay with a designated safeguarding member of staff. If a designated person is not available, in an emergency or if you are not happy with the schools action, advice from the police or MASH must be sought.

What to do if you are worried about a child:

- Write down your concerns and what has made you concerned.
- Contact the Designated Safeguarding Lead immediately.
- Give the DSL a copy of your notes. Treat all discussions/ notes as confidential.

What to do if the allegations refer to a member of staff, please contact the DSL in the first instance. If the allegation refers to the DSL (Head teacher), then contact our Safeguarding Governor Mrs S Garnham via email sgarnham@holbrookprimaryschool.com
