<u>Equipment</u>

<u>Curriculum</u>

*During the first half term our theme will be growing and plants. This will be the basis for our English and science work

*In the second half term our theme will be Africa which will include a geography focus as well as being the basis for our English work. We will also look at animal groups and lifecycles in our science work. *Our DT sewing project will be based on African animals.

*We will be continuing to explore the Muslim faith in our RE work.



*For phonics and SPaG, we will be revising both the Year 1 and Year 2 Song of Sounds scheme as well as practising our other Year 2 spelling rules.

*In maths, we will be working on fractions and measurement, including time mass, lengths and capacity. We will also be looking at statistics and revising learning from previous terms.
