Dragons and Drawbridges



English - We will be continuing Drawing Club using books about dragons and castles. We will be looking at story structure, characters and settings.



Maths – Our units are on place value within 10 then within 20, addition and subtraction within 10, and 2D and 3D Shape.

Science - Work will focus on materials and their properties.



History - We will be looking at the history of our local area and how castles have changed through the years.

Geography - We will focus on our local area and we will be learning about maps.

Computing – Programming robots and animation.

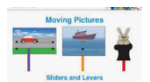


Art – Portraits inspired by Picasso and dragon sketching.
