Our Autumn Theme

Our Changing World is our autumn theme. We study *Voices In The Park* by Anthony Browne, and *The Iron Man* by Ted Hughes before half-term. Afterwards, we learn about the Romans as part of our English and history lessons.

Curriculum

Maths:

addition and subtraction
multiplication and division.

We will be focusing on our times tables all year in preparation for the Year 4 multiplication check.



English: narrative, poetry and descriptive writing.

Reading: Our class stories for this term are:

Charlie Changes into a Chicken by Sam Copeland and *The Boy at the Back of the Class* by Onjali Rauf.

History: Romans (including a trip to Fishbourne Roman Palace)

Science: Electricity and Sound

Geography: What are rivers and how are they used?

PE:

Monday - Outdoor PE

Thursday - Indoor PE (including swimming from September 17th - November 12th)

Art and DT: Portraits, line and sculpture, electrical systems

Computing: E-safety and computing systems and networks

French: revision of previous units, ice cream and presenting myself.
